Re: PhRMA's Support for Radical Organizations and Liberal Elected Officials

The Pharmaceutical Research and Manufacturers Association of America (PhRMA) is a 501(c)6 trade association representing the pharmaceutical industry in the United States. While PhRMA is reputed for contributing to right-of-center, pro-business groups, comparatively little attention (likely due to the liberal bias of investigative reporters) has been paid to the vast network of left-wing or liberal groups that PhRMA funds.

While PhRMA has contributed to a wide-array of left-leaning groups (over \$13 million to left-leaning groups identified in this report since 2017), most troubling is PhRMA's support for organizations that are pushing to advance the LGBTQ agenda. PhRMA's support for LGBTQ groups spans from the now-notorious Trevor Project, which provides counseling to teenagers on gender transitioning without parental consent, to state transgender groups, to groups that sponsor drag shows, to groups that host "pride" events. These contributions, totaling over \$595,000 from 2017 to 2021, show that PhRMA is complicit in advancing the radical LGBTQ agenda in America.

Additionally, PhRMA has contributed to groups that advocated for COVID vaccine mandates or for censoring so-called vaccine "misinformation." All told, PhRMA contributed over \$5.2 million to organizations that either supported vax mandates or that called for the removal of social media accounts that countered the pro-vax narrative.

PhRMA has also supported groups that favor amnesty for illegal immigrants, such as LULAC and UnidosUS (formerly known as National Council of La Raza). Contributions to pro-amnesty groups total \$180,000 from 2017 to 2021.

Of course, beyond their support for left-leaning groups, PhRMA has also flexed its lobbying muscle in Washington and in state capitals around the country, contributing millions of dollars to liberal candidates and committees. In Washington, PhRMA's federal PAC has contributed \$396,750 to liberal candidates and committees that support them between 2017 and 2022. PhRMA also contributed a staggering over \$4 million to major national 527 organizations that support liberal candidates such as the Democratic Governors Association (DGA), the Democratic Attorney Generals Association (DAGA), and other similar 527 groups that are active in state elections. Beyond that, PhRMA has been politically active in 20 states since 2017, either directly as a 501(c)6, or through state registered PhRMA PACs, such as in California, Colorado,



Idaho, Nevada, Oregon, and Tennessee. All told, our research found over \$9.4 million in PhRMA or PhRMA PAC contributions to liberal candidates or committees.

PhRMA SUPPORTS LEFTIST IDEOLOGICAL GROUPS

The Pharmaceutical Research and Manufacturers of America (PhRMA) is a large 501(c)6 trade association that represents the pharmaceutical industry. While it is expected that PhRMA would donate to groups that help the pharmaceutical industry, the American Accountability Foundation's research has found that beyond that type of normal lobbying activity, PhRMA is funding a far-left agenda that is corrosive to American values and the American way of life.

After reviewing PhRMA's IRS form 990s from 2017 – 2021, our research has found that:

- PhRMA has contributed over \$13 million to groups that support a liberal agenda.
- PhRMA has contributed \$595,500 to groups advancing the radical LGBTQ agenda.
- PhRMA has contributed over \$5.2 million to groups that supported vaccine mandates or silencing so-called vaccine “misinformation.”
- PhRMA has contributed \$180,000 to groups advocating for amnesty for illegal immigrants.
- PhRMA has contributed over \$197,000 to labor unions or groups closely associated with labor unions.
- PhRMA has contributed over \$8.6 million to Center Forward, a group affiliated with the “Blue Dog” Democrats and that supports the DEI agenda and raising visa caps.

PhRMA Supports the LGBTQ Agenda

PhRMA's support of groups advancing the LGBTQ agenda has been particularly pronounced. Our research has found that PhRMA has contributed at least \$595,000 to pro-LGBTQ groups.

These groups include:

- Equality California, which supported bills in California requiring teachers undergo “LGBTQ+ cultural competency training” and a bill that would require a parent's affirmation of child's gender identity be considered during child custody decisions.
- The American Academy of Child & Adolescent Psychiatry, which publishes a “Facts for Families” guide on “Transgender and Gender Diverse Youth” that provides guidance on medical and surgical gender transitioning.
- Diversity Richmond, which sponsors events such as “drag bingos.”
- The Human Rights Campaign, which pushes the LGBTQ agenda in workplaces and schools.
- The LGBTQ Victory Institute, which aims to place LGBTQ individuals in presidential appointments.



- The Trevor Project, which offers counseling on gender transitions without parental consent to teenagers.
- The Maine Transgender Network, which opposed a bill to establish a rating system for books in school libraries and opposed a bill to allow only female students to participate in girls' school sports.
- The Center for Black Equity, which sponsors black LGBTQ pride events and brands itself as "an alternative to the largely white mainstream LGBTQ+ movement."

Equality California

PhRMA contributed \$15,000 to a group named Equality California in 2017, their IRS Form 990 reveals:

Equality California supports a wide range of legislation at the federal and state levels that further the LGBTQ Agenda, such as a bill requiring teachers to undergo LGBTQ cultural competency training and a bill requiring child custody and visitation decisions to account for parents' affirmation of a child's gender identity:¹

AB 5 (Zbur): Safe and Supportive Schools Program

AB 5 will require teachers and school staff serving grades 7-12 to complete one hour of LGBTQ+ cultural competency training, with a sunset after 5 years. The bill will provide teachers and staff with the tools and training they need to support LGBTQ+ students and make California schools safer and more supportive for all students.

Status: Signed into law by Governor Newsom on September 23, 2023.

AB 957 (Wilson): TGI Youth Empowerment Act

AB 957 will update California law to clarify that, for the purposes of child custody and visitation decisions, a parent's affirmation of a child's gender identity or gender expression is an essential factor that must be considered in determining the best interest of the child. Family acceptance of LGBTQ+ youth is a crucial protective factor in combatting depression and can drastically reduce rates of suicide.

*Status: **Vetoed by Governor Newsom on September 22, 2023.***

The Los Angeles LGBT Center

PhRMA has contributed \$80,000 to the Los Angeles LGBT Center since 2018.

The Los Angeles LGBT Center² has portrayed parents opposed to certain LGBTQ educational policies as right-wing extremists. The Center's article "How Los Angeles Became the Newest Target in the War on LGBTQ+ Education" discusses a perceived increase in anti-LGBTQ+ sentiment in Southern California, specifically criticizing parental resistance as a "far-right" effort to undermine inclusive education.³

Schools across the country are witnessing a surge in discriminatory policy and harmful rhetoric targeting LGBTQ+ youth—and unfortunately, southern California is no stranger to hate. Since the beginning of the summer, right-wing extremists have protested queer and trans inclusion at school board meetings for the Glendale and Los Angeles Unified School Districts. Over the same time span, the Chino Hills, Murietta, and Temecula Valley Unified School Districts have all adopted policies forcing teachers to out trans students to their parents.

These controversies are best understood as part of a far-right campaign to radicalize schools and strip away supportive resources for kids, and California parents say that it's making their children feel vulnerable in schools they always assumed were safe places. Jane Owen, a Glendale mother who asked to be referred to by a pseudonym, has a child in second grade, and her youngest is entering Kindergarten this year. She is terrified to send her kids to school after attending a school board meeting on June 20 in which conservative protesters, many of whom didn't have children in the district, clashed with supporters of the LGBTQ+ community over the district's decision to recognize Pride Month. The violence followed a similarly raucous meeting exactly two weeks earlier, resulting in at least four arrests between them...

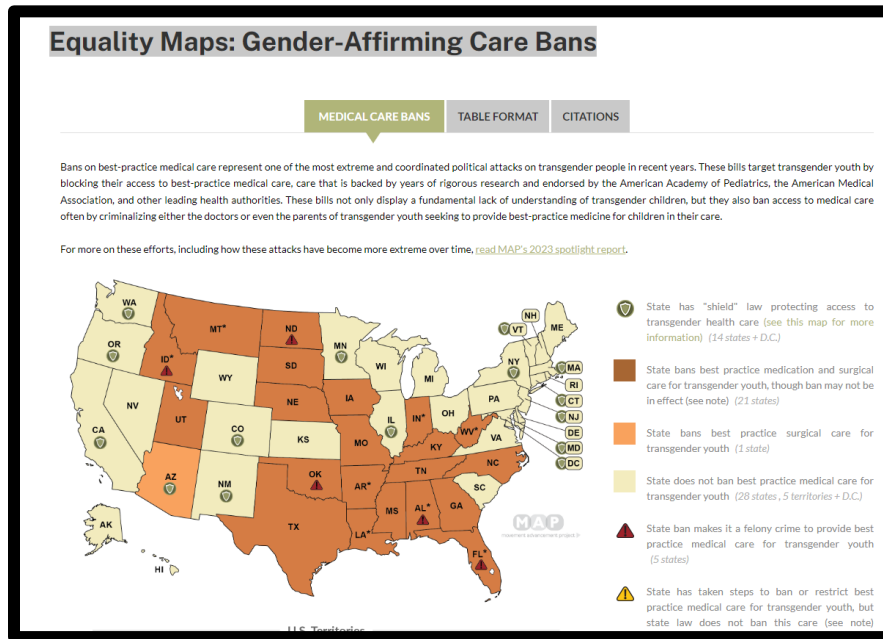

AACAP provides a "Facts for Families" guide on "Transgender and Gender Diverse Youth" that provides guidance on medical and surgical gender transitioning:⁵

...Sometimes children take steps to transition from their assigned gender to their affirmed gender. This is called transitioning. Social transitioning refers to a change of gender roles, expressions, name, and pronouns. **Medical transitioning refers to the use of medication to help their body better match their gender identity. Medications can pause some of the physical changes that happen with puberty. Surgical transitioning refers to the use of surgery to match one's body and gender identity. Surgery is not an option until late adolescence and adulthood.** If transitioning is something your child is wondering about, you can explore options with a medical professional who is knowledgeable in this area. These treatments are different from conversion therapy which attempts to force gender identity to match assigned gender. Conversion therapy is not based on evidence and is harmful to the child and their relationship with their parents...

...Still, the Latino Commission on AIDS is taking a necessary and proud stance with the drag community. Drag artists have been at the forefront of challenging harmful gender stereotypes and have amplified HIV education throughout the history of the epidemic while contributing to spaces of joy and community healing.

"The drag community has used its platform to fundraise for our cause. Many kings and queens have taken public stands against HIV stigma, while drag shows have continuously provided local programs space for HIV testing and education. Drag shows are just the latest targets for anti-LGBTQ lawmakers, who have no idea how liberating a drag show can be. Now is the time for the HIV community to give back to one of our strongest allies by speaking up against the harmful bills, protests, and homophobic/transphobic rhetoric targeting this community." says Edric Figueroa the director of Zero Campaigns at the Latino Commission on AIDS...

- ✓ Give context about identities in our community and why respect towards those identities is important. This includes pronouns and terminology.
- ✓ Provide a safe and non-judgmental space for providers/ employees to learn and create dialogue about bettering services for LGBTQ+ people.
- ✓ Discuss creating an affirming culture within your organization for clientele and employees. This includes imagery, paperwork and policies.

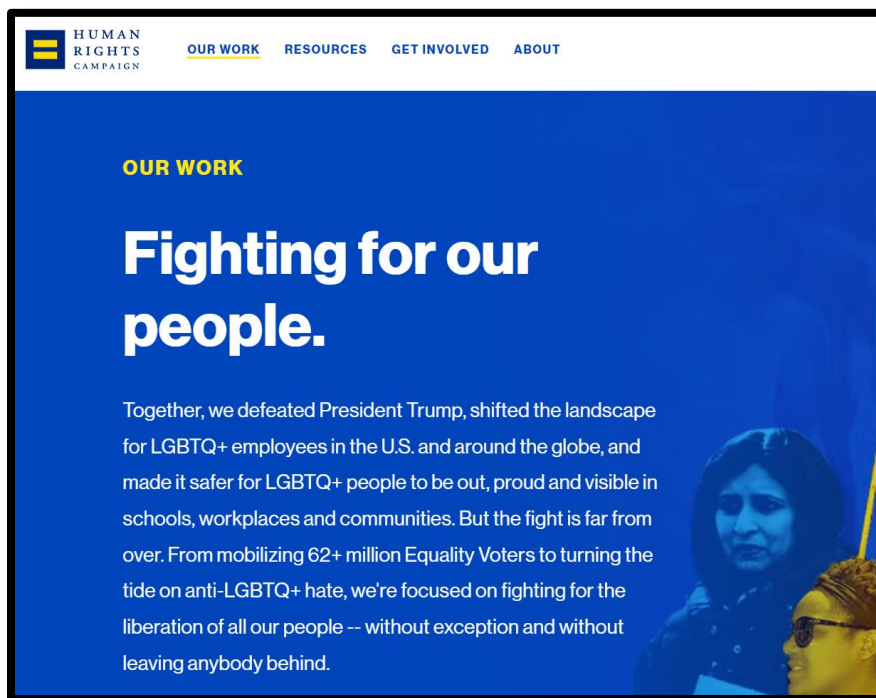

According to their website⁹, the Human Rights Campaign (HRC) PhRMA has boasted that “we defeated President Trump,” “shifted the landscape for LGBTQ+ employees in the U.S. and around the globe,” and that they are “focused on fighting for the liberation of all our people.”



The HRC Foundation published LGBTQ resources for schools, such as a “Checklist for a Gender Inclusive Classroom”:¹⁰

Checklist for a Gender Inclusive Classroom

- **Use inclusive phrases** to address your class that are not gendered such as, "Good morning, everyone" or "Good morning, scholars" or choose and use a name for your class like the Dolphins or the Owls.
- **Develop classroom messages** that emphasize "All children can... (dance, cook, have short or long hair, do math, make art, etc.)"
- **Group students in ways that do not rely on gender** such as table groups, letters in their names or colors of their clothes. Avoid situations that force children to make gendered choices, such as boys line up here and girls line up there.
- **Provide role models.** Show a wide range of achievements and emotions for all people that move beyond gender-role stereotypes. [Read diverse biographies.](#)
- **Read books to your class** that teach about gender and breakdown stereotypes related to gender expression and gender identity.
- **Use lesson plans** designed to expand student's understanding of gender. Read books that encourage discussion of gender assumptions. Help students see the limitations of gender stereotyping. Ask your class to examine popular culture, advertising, or children's toys and books for gender stereotypes.

The Trevor Project provides information to minors about gender transitions and offers counseling without parental consent.¹²

We may also make a report to an appropriate party, and make any disclosures we reasonably believe necessary, to prevent another person's death or serious injury. Unless otherwise required by applicable law (including in response to a subpoena that we reasonably believe is valid), we will not disclose personal or sensitive information to parents, legal guardians, or other individuals.

Additionally, former Biden Administration Department of Energy official Sam Brinton previously led The Trevor Project's advocacy and government affairs efforts.¹³

The Maine Transgender Network¹⁴ opposed a bill to establish a rating system for books in school libraries (LD 1008), opposed a bill to allow only female students to participate in girls school sports (LD 930), and opposed a bill to eliminate critical race theory, social and emotional learning, and DEI in school curricula (LD 618), among many others in the 2023 Maine legislative session.¹⁵

Equality Virginia Inc is an activist group advocating for LGBTQ+ rights, known for its criticism of prominent conservative Glenn Youngkin and his efforts to shield youth from gender and LGBTQ leftist ideology.

In a July 2023 press release, Narissa Rahaman, executive director of Equality Virginia, stated:¹⁶

"Today, Governor Youngkin and the VDOE made a dangerous, politically motivated decision to ignore the thousands of Virginians who submitted public comments opposing his proposed model policies – policies which single out transgender and nonbinary youth in our schools. Youngkin did all of this with no input from LGBTQ+ advocacy groups nor subject matter experts. Throughout the comment process, Virginians made it clear that LGBTQ+ youth deserve safety, respect, and the opportunity to thrive." Rahaman continued, "This comes on the heels of a scathing 18-month report released last week by JLARC detailing how Virginia is underfunding its K-12 public schools at a lower rate than national and regional averages. Instead of addressing the real issues, Governor Youngkin's response is to escalate a culture war and drop a policy that harms kids, removes resources for teachers, and ignores the rights of parents in Virginia."...

The Center for Black Equity hosts “Black LGBTQ+ Pride Celebrations” and describes itself as “an alternative to the largely white mainstream LGBTQ+ movement.”¹⁷



PhRMA CONTRIBUTES TO GROUPS THAT SUPPORT COVID VAX MANDATES OR VACCINE CENSORSHIP

PhRMA has given \$5.281 million to groups that supported COVID vaccine mandates or that supported censorship of so-called vaccine “misinformation.” Contributions to these groups are detailed below.

American Lung Association

PhRMA contributed \$1,308,050 to The American Lung Association from 2018 to 2021, according to the PhRMA’s form 990s. The American Lung Association lauded New York Governor Kathy Hochul for expanding a restrictive “vaccine or mask requirement,” stating, “we commend Governor Hochul and New York State for putting the health of New Yorkers first. As the COVID-19 pandemic and emerging variants, including Omicron and Delta, continue to endanger New Yorkers and people around the world, vaccinations and indoor masking are critical tools we must use to protect our most vulnerable populations.”¹⁸ This regulation required masks to be worn

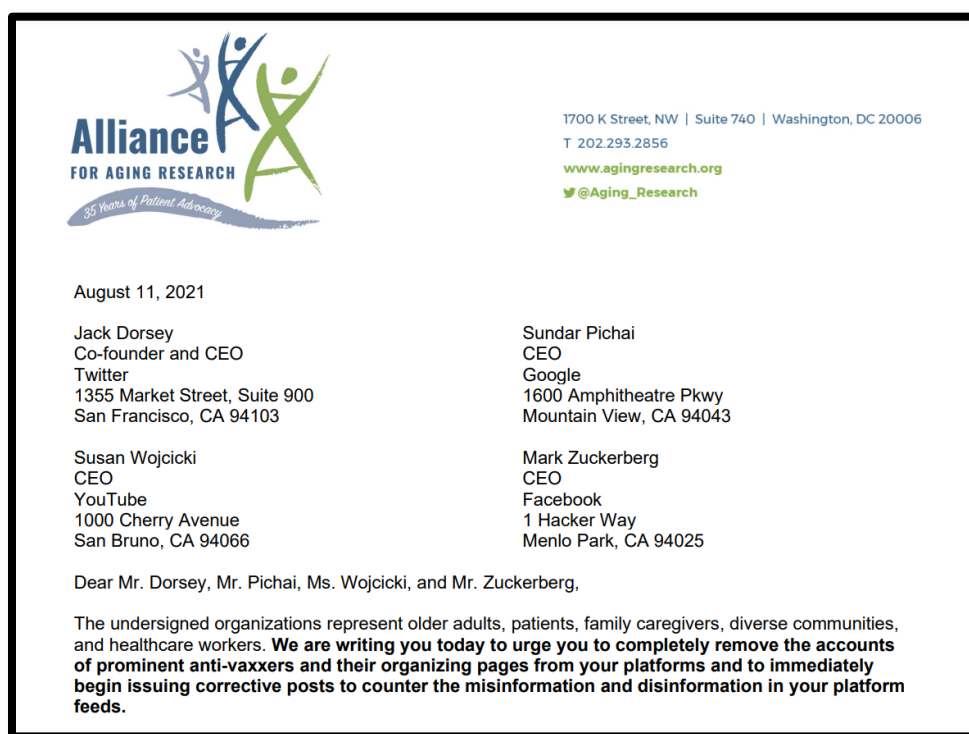

In August 2021, the Alliance for Aging Research wrote a coalition letter to the CEOs of Twitter, Google, YouTube, and Facebook asking that the social media platforms “completely remove the accounts of prominent anti-vaxxers and their organizing pages from your platforms and to immediately begin issuing corrective posts to counter the misinformation and disinformation in your platform feeds”.²⁰

PhRMA Contributed to Five Groups that Co-Signed Statement in Support of Requiring COVID Vax for Health Care Workers

In July 2021, the American Association of Medical Colleges released a joint statement calling on health care employers to require that health care employees be required to receive the COVID-19 vaccine:²¹

*With COVID-19 case counts rising amid the spread of the Delta variant, **more than 50 health care professional societies and organizations called for all health care employers to require their employees to be vaccinated against COVID-19** in a joint statement released today. These societies and organizations represent millions of workers throughout health and long-term care – from doctors and nurses to pharmacists and physician assistants, from public health workers and epidemiologists to long-term care, home care, and hospice workers.*

***Their endorsement of mandatory COVID-19 vaccination for health care workers** aims to protect the safety of patients and residents of long-term care facilities and make the health care sector a leader in COVID-19 vaccination just as cases, hospitalizations, and deaths are once again rising throughout the United States...*

PhRMA has contributed to five of these signatories since 2017. These contributions total \$401,000.

The American Medical Association released a joint statement in November 2021 that called on the business community to support the federal requirement that employees working for companies with more than 100 employees be vaccinated for COVID:²²

*Nov. 18, 2021 — Organizations representing the country's doctors, nurses, pharmacists, and other health professionals joined with some of the country's most prominent health care experts **to call on the business community to support the new federal requirement that those working for companies with more than 100 employees be vaccinated for COVID.***

Those signing the statement include professional organizations such as: the American Medical Association, the American College of Physicians, the National Hispanic Medical Association, the National League for Nursing, the National Medical Association, and the American Public Health Association plus prominent health leaders such as: Ezekiel Emanuel, Robert M. Wachter, Eric Topol, Tom Frieden, Andy Slavitt, Megan Ranney, Rick Bright, Ashish K. Jha, Luciana Borio, Uché Blackstock, Oni Blackstock, Michael Osterholm, and David Michaels.

*"Instead of wasting time in court trying to overturn these mandates, business leaders should be focused on how to protect their employees from COVID through vaccination. That's the only way we'll be able to return to normal and stabilize our economy," said Emanuel, Vice Provost for Global Initiatives at the University of Pennsylvania, who organized the statement. **"We've seen over and over that employer vaccine mandates work to raise vaccination rates, and they don't cause workforce shortages. It's time for the business community to step up and show the leadership our nation needs now."***

Vaccines are extremely effective in preventing COVID cases, hospitalizations, and deaths. Compared to the vaccinated, the unvaccinated are 11 times more likely to die. Any risk in receiving the vaccine is considerably less common and less serious than the consequences of contracting COVID...

LULAC supports a long list of liberal, pro-illegal immigration policies, such as opposing “any efforts to construct a border wall” and allowing “undocumented workers already in the U.S” a “pathway to citizenship”:²³

...LULAC demands an end to all deportations, excluding individuals convicted of a violent felony, while comprehensive immigration reform legislation is being considered. LULAC supports the repeal of the bed-detention quota language included annually in the Department of Homeland Security appropriation legislation. LULAC also calls on the immediate end to family detention practices and urges the Department of Homeland Security to adhere to the November 20, 2014 memo titled Policies for the Apprehension, Detention and Removal of Undocumented Immigrants.

*LULAC opposes any legislation that threatens the rights of immigrants, criminalizes them or those who provide them assistance, and harms Latino communities. Legal residents and naturalized citizens should have the same benefits due native-born citizens. LULAC opposes the militarization of the border and vigilante attacks on immigrants, as well as the mistreatment of immigrants in the United States, and their territories, regardless of their status. **LULAC supports comprehensive immigration reform that provides an avenue for undocumented workers to legalize their status and expands the number of legal immigrants allowed into the U.S. to meet our needs. LULAC opposes any efforts to construct a border wall.***

*LULAC opposes immigration legislative language that preconditions status adjustment on border security triggers. **LULAC favors a prompt avenue to citizenship...***

...LULAC supports comprehensive immigration reform legislation that:

- ***Allows undocumented workers already in the U.S. to contribute to the U.S. economy and society by providing them with a pathway to citizenship;***

UnidosUS is supportive of a pathway to citizenship for 11 million illegal immigrants, having given their support for the proposed U.S. Citizenship Act of 2021.²⁶

*"Today's introduction of the U.S. Citizenship Act of 2021 by Senator Menendez, Rep. Linda Sanchez, leaders of the Congressional Hispanic Caucus (CHC) and other members of Congress animates the bold vision set forth by the Biden administration. **This legislation establishes a much-needed earned pathway to citizenship for 11 million immigrants** and begins to chart a new course for an effective and humane 21st century immigration system.*

*"This important bill includes critical improvements, **like fast-tracking legalization for DREAMers and farmworkers**, as well as modernizing our legal immigration system by, among other things, eliminating harmful barriers to family unity. In addition to supporting liberal 501(c)3, 501(c)4, and other similar organizations, PhRMA has been heavily involved in making political contributions to candidates, party committees, leadership PACs, independent expenditure committees, and inaugural committees that support liberal candidates for office.

All told, our research has found that PhRMA, both directly as a 501(c)6 and through its network of state-registered political action committees, has contributed a total of \$9,477,025 to committees that support liberal candidates between 2017 and 2022 (until 2021 for expenditures out of PhRMA 501(c)6).

These contributions include:

- \$396,750 to federal liberal candidates, their leadership PACs and party committees.
- Over \$4 million to major national 527 political committees that support liberal candidates, such as the Democratic Governors Association (DGA) and the Democratic Attorney Generals Association (DAGA), and others.
- Over \$1.6 million to committees that support liberal candidates in California.
- Over \$1.3 million to committees that support liberal candidates in New York State.
